Presentation 1.

Autism spectrum disorders (ASD).

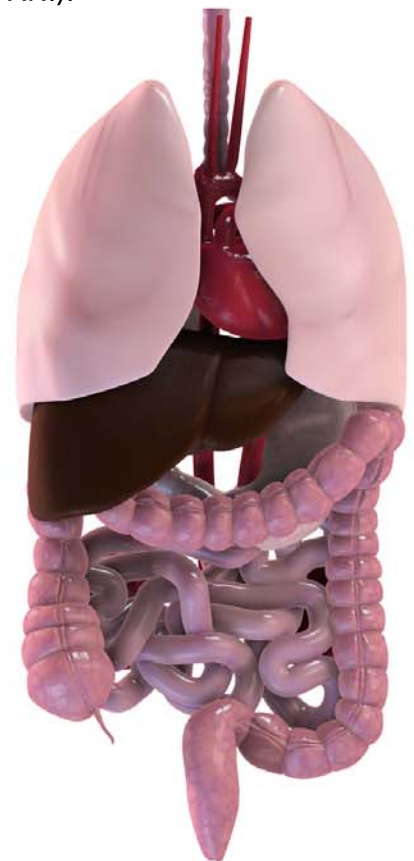
Up-to-date information will be presented on biomedical treatments pioneered by the American based group Defeat Autism Now! (DAN!).

These include gluten/casein free diets, heavy metal detoxication, treatment of imbalanced intestinal yeast/bacteria, nutrient therapies, etc.

Presentation 2.

Irritable Bowel Syndrome (IBS).

Common causes of IBS include chronic intestinal infection (parasitic, fungal, bacterial), imbalanced healthy bacteria (flora), food intolerances such as fructose malabsorption, lactose intolerance, and gluten intolerance, and poor digestive function (stomach acid/pancreatic enzyme/bile acid insufficiency). Methods for identifying and treating the causes of IBS will be discussed.
